## Faculty Bios

John "Comix" Barrella is a Street Dance Educator, Choreographer, Performer, Consultant & Company Director. He is a distinguished figure in the dance community, with a primary focus on street dance culture. A versatile artist, he employs techniques rooted in Locking, Popping, B-boy, and Hip Hop. Notably featured in music videos such as "Get Away" by Alissia and "HSKT" by Tenin, John's portfolio extends to high-profile events like Tedx: Chaos, halftime shows for the NY Knicks, and the NYC Breakers' Battle of the Boroughs reunion. As a renowned choreographer, John's work resonates on the international stage. His unique movement approach has left an indelible mark on dancers in numerous schools, programs, and teams globally. As the owner/director of the dance company "Redef" since 2007, John's artistic vision comes to life in performances across NJ, NY, and Philadelphia. His comedy-based work, "Stupid Humans," offers satirical takes on the performing arts through live shows and dance films. Beyond directing the company, John serves as an adjunct professor for Hip Hop at Rider University, contributes to various arts boards, presents at numerous conventions, and appears in dance education facilities internationally to train both students and teachers. In recent years, John has pioneered "The Comix Method", a program training teachers globally in hip-hop terminology, technique, and educational practices. Applied in classrooms worldwide, this program reflects John's unique instructional method. His classes and events aim to instill aspiring dancers with the fundamentals of street and Hip Hop dance, promoting both freestyle artistry and mastery of choreography. John's overarching goal is to inspire individuals to become artists and creatively challenge themselves, fostering positive growth both within and beyond the realm of dance.

Ryan Cappleman is a performer, choreographer, musician, teaching artist, and director based in Milwaukee. Select performance credits: Jake in Waiting...a Song Cycle Off Broadway at the Cherry Lane Theatre, Dirty Bob in Lumberjacks in Love at the Milwaukee Rep, the Scarecrow in The Wizard of Oz, Pooh-Bah in The Hot Mikado, Woof in Hair at Skylight, Britton in La La Lucille, the Piano Player in Billy Bishop Goes to War at Third Avenue Playworks, Cornelius Hackl in Hello, Dolly! at Forte Theatre. As a choreographer, Ryan has earned three Footlights Awards for Outstanding Choreography in a Professional Musical (Pirates of Penzance, Sweeney Todd, and Hairspray all at Skylight). He choreographed the music video of "Dancing Round My Problems" for artist Reagan Beem, which has over a million views on TikTok. Ryan has been a pianist for 32 years, and has served as a music director, pit musician, arranger, and conductor for many productions, cabarets, and concerts. Highlights include arranging and performing "Let It Be" with Tony Nominee Christopher Jackson, music director for Grammy Winner Kurt Ollmann, and being a former member of the Irish Band Tallymoore. Ryan was on faculty at UW Parkside, where he helped develop the Dance Minor for the theater department. He's also been a teaching artist at UW Milwaukee, the Milwaukee Ballet Summer Intensive, the Minnesota Conservatory for the Arts Summer Dance Intensive, the Virginia State Thespian Conference, First Stage, Danceworks, Skylight, and many more. He will be directing The Secret Garden this coming spring for Forte Theatre, where he is an associate artist. He is a proud dog dad to Dolly, the black mouth cur, who he adopted from the Door County Humane Society.

Jamie Harris has been dancing since the age of three and teaching since 2002. Starting her training under Kathleen Sims Villari (Ballet Russe De Monte Carlo) and Maria Villari at American Dance Center where she trained in Ballet, Tap, Jazz, and Modern. She performed nationwide including the International Dance Festival in California. She was a cast member of Chicagoland's longest running original ballet "Hansel and Gretel" from 1995-2000. She also performed in The Joffery Ballet's "Nutcracker". Jamie's modern training (Graham, Horton, and Cunningham) came from Melody Geraci. Jamie also trained with Olga Ravasi, Joel Hall, Dardi Mcginley-Galivan, Christie Lowe (ABT), Eduardo Vilaro (Ballet Hispanico), Adam Sklute (Ballet West), and John Magnus (Joffery Ballet) to name a few. She continued her education at Columbia College Chicago where she majored in Dance. She is a registered CNA in the state of Illinois. Jamie worked with Alzheimers and Dementia residents whom she loved running dance and exercise classes with. She continues her training as she never wants to stop learning and growing as an artist. She is a certified instructor for Joel Hall technique. She is certified in Progressing Ballet Technique. Jamie has also been certified in Discover Dance, a child dance and development program. She was formerly YPAD (Youth Protection Advocates in Dance) Certified which was a child safety program with extensive training, background checks, CPR and much more. She has been teaching in the Chicagoland area for over 20 years and continues to guest teach and substitute teach where she is needed. Jamie is currently at Leap of Faith in Plainfield, IL and IPAC in Frankfort, IL. She has taught for conventions such as Dance Masters Wisconsin. She enjoys judging and teaching at local conventions and competitions. Some of Jamie's favorite musical credits include, Gypsy, 1776, Music Man, and Cats. Jamie is the founder of the Child Exploitation Awareness Task Force (CEAT) which is an organization promoting awareness and education on child safety, social media safety, exploitation, abuse, and trafficking. Jamie, her husband David, and their two children Lila and Killian reside in Plainfield II.

Gabi Sustache, a Milwaukee native, is a performer, choreographer, and dance educator. A graduate from UW-Milwaukee, where she received her Bachelors of Arts from the Dance program in Spring of 2020. Gabi is a company member with Danceworks Performance MKE and enjoys performinging with various Milwaukee-based hip hop dancers. In 2022, Gabi competed in World Of Dance, Los Angeles. She is also the Studio Education Director at Danceworks and the Artistic Manager of Danceworks Youth Performance Company. Her choreography has been featured at Milwaukee Bucks halftime performances, for several high school musical theater productions in and around the Milwaukee area and was selected to be adjudicated at the American College Dance Association's North Central Conference.
